



Rannoch Community Trust - Community Forum – FAQs

1. What is the RCT Community Forum?

The Forum is being created to help RCT review and refresh its priorities.

RCT's Community Action / Development Plan was written over ten years ago, and the Board wants to hear from a wider range of residents about what matters most for Rannoch's future.

The Forum is not a standalone community group. It sits within RCT and feeds into Board discussions and planning.

2. Is it the same as the Community Council?

No. The Community Forum is run by Rannoch Community Trust (RCT) and focuses on sharing ideas and giving feedback to help shape RCT plans and projects.

The Community Council is a separate group. If anything comes up in the Forum that would be better taken forward by the Community Council, we can share it with them so the right group can take it forward.

3. What will the Forum do?

The Forum will help RCT to:

- Hear ideas and community views
- Get feedback on RCT plans and projects
- Make sure a range of local voices are represented

This could include discussing future priorities and giving feedback on projects such as The CornerStone, local care initiatives and affordable housing.

4. Does the Forum make decisions?

No. The Community Forum is advisory, it's a chance to share views and provide feedback. RCT will always remain responsible for making decisions and taking plans forward.

5. Who can join?

Any local resident with an interest in Rannoch is welcome to express interest.

6. Do I need experience?

No experience needed, just a willingness to share your views constructively.

7. What's the time commitment?

No big-time commitment required. We'll keep it manageable and realistic for busy lives.

8. How will the Forum meet?

We expect meetings to be informal and accessible (details will be confirmed once the group is formed).

9. How will views be used?

Forum feedback will be shared with RCT and used to help inform planning and future work. RCT will always remain responsible for final decisions and delivery.
